
# June Newsletter

- \* Thank you to the 53 participants attending the Hamlet meeting on May 27th. A lot of progress was made on legislative requirements and community direction. The Board will be reviewing procedures to assist us in running the meeting more smoothly. Pending minutes can be found on the RM website by <u>CLICKING HERE</u>.
- \* Collingwood road spring maintenance is ongoing. We had a few hiccups with rain, dust proofing delayed, more rain and changing our packer rental company suddenly, but the 4 stages of maintenance (grading, gravel, dust proofing and packing) approved at our May 27th meeting have occurred. It is also our plan to fill and tamp down potholes in a timely fashion.
- By the long weekend new signage will be installed in the Lorras bin area, the Narrows, and road signs informing visitors and community members that dogs must be leashed in Collingwood.





- We would like to thank Forest Gump's family that volunteered to drive 4-8 hour shifts packing our Collingwood roads. Many thanks to Herb Gump, Gary Gump, Lana Gump, June Gump, Ron Gump and the twins Peter & Perry Gump.
- Speaking of volunteers, an application has been submitted to the Water Security Agency to tidy up the shoreline at the *Narrows* (the municipal reserve between 100 & 102 Gordon Drive). We'll keep you posted on the date and time for this call for volunteers.
- \* As discussed at the May hamlet meeting, on our behalf the RM has negotiated a fair price of \$25,000 for the land on the north side of the boat launch parking area.
- The Hamlet is working on securing a Yard Waste Bin for trees, shrubs and grass clippings. This will help reduce the material taken to our local landfill thus preserving the life of our landfill and keeping our utility costs reasonable. We will be placing the Yard Waste Bin in the boat launch area. Stay tuned.
