



## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE PROVISION OF NOTARY PUBLIC AND COMMISSIONER OF OATH REQUESTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Notary Public and Commissioner of Oath Fee Bylaw.
2. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Act" shall mean *The Municipalities Act*.
  - b) "Designated officer" shall mean the Administrator of the municipality or any other person who has been assigned responsibility to issue tax certificates by the council of the municipality.
  - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220.
3. Upon receipt of:
  - a) a verbal, written or electronic request for Notary Public or Commissioner of Oath service, and
  - b) the appropriate fee as described in Schedule 1, attached hereto, and forming a part of this bylaw, the Municipality shall provide to the applicant the requested information or service.
4. As per Subsection 8(1)(i) of the Act, providing Notary Public and/or Commissioner of Oath is a service provided by the Municipality.
5. This bylaw shall come into force on the day on which it is passed.
