**PART IV: NARRATIVE INTERPRETATION OF ABOVE STATISTICS**

**The following is provided to the Chief, Mayor, Reeve, Administrator, Council or Community Representative on policing initiatives and general policing information. It should be hand delivered whenever possible.**

**1. Crime trends/problems: (Gangs, Drugs, Domestic Violence, Traffic etc.)**

Southey/Strasbourg Detachment responded to **710** calls for service / incidents that occurred between October 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> of this year while responding to **948** calls for service/ incidents during this same reporting period last year (2020). There were **26** calls for service / incidents that originated from the RM of McKillop for this reporting period compared to **58** calls for service / incidents from this same reporting period last year.

**2. Crime Prevention initiatives (school visitation, DARE, programs, interagency/council meetings)**

Consultation continues with our elected officials / communities to discuss areas of concern and to assist us in achieving our priorities and objectives which were set for the 2021-2022 Annual Performance Plan.

We continue to focus on crime reduction / prevention and traffic safety. We hope to become more involved in our schools and communities once COVID restrictions are lifted.

**3. Feed Back on Police Management Board Meetings (issues / concerns)**

The third quarter of our 2021/22 reporting year is complete. We continue to work on the initiatives set out in our Annual Performance Plan (APP). Due to the Pandemic, no Town Hall meetings or Community Consultative Group Meetings have been held. We continue to focus on reducing property crime, dealing with traffic issues / concerns and creating a valued and trusted workplace.

**4. Other significant issues: (infrastructure, resources, change administration)**

Southey/Strasbourg Detachment has a total of 9.5 positions. The Detachment compliment includes: 1 Sergeant, 1 Corporal, 6 Constables, 1 Full time Public Servant in Southey and 1 - part time Public Servant in Strasbourg. There is 1 Constable position and 1 Sergeant position that are

currently vacant.

Sgt. Doug MacDougall was promoted and posted in November after only a month in the Detachment Commander position. Sgt. Kim Stewart was named as his replacement; however, there have been some delays to her start date and she is now expected to start in mid to late March.

One Constable is in the process of being posted out; however, a new Constable is being posted out of Depot to replace him and is also expected to start in late March.


