2. APAS submission on border carbon adjustments: On January 31, APAS made a submission to Finance Canada about border carbon adjustments. 3. APAS sending resolutions to CFA: APAS Representatives recently adopted 26 policy resolutions at the APAS General Meeting, so we'll be sending some of those resolutions onward to the Canadian Federation of Agriculture's AGM that will take place in Ottawa at the beginning of March.

4. APAS farm safety webinar with SaskPower: On February 1, APAS hosted a farm safety webinar with Jason Matity from SaskPower.
