The Administrative Financial Officer shall be responsible to make a determination relating to whether or not the information is appropriate to be posted on the website, based on the content presented in the information.
- 8. No documents containing personal information relating to any member of Council, employee, or ratepayer shall be posted on the website unless the individual about which the personal information is disclosed provides written consent to the Administrative Financial Officer.
