Four commercial picnic tables were purchased for \$5,327.96 (tax incl). Many thanks to the Roberts, Bitz and Epema families for volunteering to transport the tables from Regina and assemble them on one of the hottest days of the summer — 🍷

Currently the blue and red picnic tables are on the sand at the north public reserve (aka beach) and the green and tan tables on the municipal reserve beside 100 Gordon Drive.

The picnic tables have built-in umbrella support so bring your parasols to the lakeshore for shade.
