



A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

WHEREAS section 373 of *The Municipalities Act* allows a Council to appoint any Bylaw Enforcement Officers that it considers necessary and define their duties and fix their remuneration; and

WHEREAS subsection 110(4) of *The Municipalities Act* allows that an Administrator may delegate any of his or her powers, duties or functions to any employee of the Municipality, subject to the approval of Council;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

- 1.1. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the expression:
 - (a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220; and
 - (b) "RM" means the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220.

2. Appointment

- 2.1. Council hereby appoints Canadian Corps of Commissionaires (South Saskatchewan Division) as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the RM.

3. Term

- 3.1. The appointment shall commence May 1, 2018.
- 3.2. The appointment shall be reviewed by Council annually on May 1 of each year.
- 3.3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving thirty (30) days written notice.

4. Duties

- 4.1. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - (a) To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the Council of the RM;
 - (b) To represent the RM before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a Bylaw; and
 - (c) and other duties as may be assigned by Council or its delegate

5. Repeal of Former Bylaw

- 5.1. Bylaw No. 329/2017, adopted on April 20, 2017, is hereby repealed.



6. Coming Into Force

6.1. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on May 1, 2018.
