Review of the minutes of May 2, 2006 meeting – Randy Hordichuk moved the adoption of the minutes. Seconded by Joanne Moldenhauer. Carried.

Election of Chairperson for 3 year term. Bruce nominated Garry Krivoshein. Seconded by Wayne Thrasher. Carried.

Old Business:

Larvicide – Joyce Rieder will explore the name of the person/company Southey purchased larvicide from.

Storage Shed – To date Gord Jensen has not specified an area for this.

Street Light – Randy Hordichuk moved to put a street light behind Bruce and Joanne Moldenhauer's property. Rhonda Hordichuk seconded. Carried.

Informational Items:

- A. Parcs membership subscription was renewed at a cost of \$50.00. To learn more about Parcs and what they do for resort hamlets please visit their website at www.parcs-sk.com.
- B. A sanitary levey was set at \$75.00 for 2006 against all properties within hamlets who receive sanitary service and further that the levy against organized hamlets be charged against hamlet accounts.
- C. That all buildings with a permanent foundation or a minimum of 100 sq. feet sq. footage be staked by a surveyor and a surveyor's certificate be provided upon completion.
- D. Patrol and man fees: \$150.00 / hour. A min of a ½ hour call out. Mower and man \$100.00 / hour.
- E. Tax allotment rebate set at 43% for 2007.
- F. June 12/06 : Paid Robert Barber to cut and plow fire guard at a cost of \$500.00
- G. July 4 and 11: Paid Robert Barber \$225.25 to disk fire guard.

New Business:

Rhonda Hordichuk moved to pay Tony Tumak \$400.00 for grass cutting. Bruce Moldenhaur seconded. Carried.

Joanne Moldenhaur moved to pay Fred Stein \$500.00 for the use of his land for sewage disposal. Seconded by Randy Hordichuk. Carried.

Bruce Moldenhaur made a motion to talk to Jim McKee regarding options for road repair and the board will choose appropriate option within budget. Seconded by Russ Berjian. Carried.

Wayne Thrasher made a motion to do a general mail out to remind people about appropriate speed within the hamlet. Seconded by Bruce Moldenhaur. Carried.

Wayne Thrasher made a motion to further investigate options for snow removal and if necessary call a meeting in the fall to make a decision. Seconded by Rhonda Hordichuk. Carried.

Wayne Thrasher moved to include no dumping of non organic materials anywhere in the development in the mail out. Seconded by Randy Hordichuk. Carried.
