

Council Meeting Highlights – May 7, 2018

The full minutes of each Council meeting are posted online, but minutes must be approved at the following Council meeting before release, causing a delay before they can be made public.

This “Highlights” document allows ratepayers who have not attended a Council meeting to be kept up-to-date on major decisions in a timely fashion, while waiting for full minutes to be officially approved and posted.

Highlights of a brief Special Meeting of Council of the RM of McKillop No. 220 at 7:30 a.m., May 7, 2018 were as follows:

- **Petitions**

The meeting was held to move forward on two contradictory petitions that have been submitted to Council:

- An earlier petition had already been directed to a judicial review. That petition seeks a referendum on division boundaries.
- A more recent petition on the same topic has now been received and was moved forward to legal counsel at the special meeting with the hope that the petition can be considered in the same judicial review. That second petition seeks a move to urban status for the lake shore areas instead of boundary changes.

Council’s intent is that the existing judicial review can resolve the contradictions between the two petitions.

- **Assessment roll**

The meeting also gave second reading to a bylaw to extend the time required to complete the assessment roll. This bylaw resulted from a delay in SAMA’s provision of assessment information to the RM.

The next Council meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 14, 2018.
