In regards to permitting speed bumps in the Hamlet of Mohr's Beach and based on the following:

- Motion: 196/2017 regarding the temporary allowance of speed bumps in Hamlet communities in the 2017 season.
- Multiple email correspondence between the Hamlet Board and the RM office specifically: October 12, 2017 & January 7, 2018
- Multiple conversations between past and current board members with members of Council as well as staff in the Council office.
- Submission of a map locating placement of speed bumps through the Hamlet provided to the RM office.

The Hamlet Board respectfully requests that the Council issue a resolution before March 5th that would support the installation of speed bumps in the Hamlet of Mohr's beach as noted below:

- That the RM of McKillop No 220 Council permit the Organized Hamlet's to allow temporary speedbumps for the 2018 and subsequent seasons prior to Council passing a Traffic Bylaw provided the provincial regulations are met and the proper signage is legal. At such time when the Traffic Bylaw has been passed, this motion will be rescinded.

Our residents have on numerous occasions expressed safety concerns to the Hamlet Board. Citing legal and liability considerations as communicated by the RM to the Hamlet Board, we have not acted on the installation of speed bumps. We would appreciate that this motion can be passed in time for the upcoming season in order to ensure we are able to serve the members of our community.
