

NORTH COLESDALE PARK MEETING

OLD BUSINESS:

John Flowers said the street lights are coming. We are waiting on Sask. Power.

Bruce Meggeson is to check with Sask. Power re gas lines, costs, etc.

NEW BUSINESS:

Roger Ralston showed an artist's concept of a sign for the entrance to our resort. The cost is \$1,400.00 plus GST, to be built in the Spring of 1995.

Romy Shewaga made a motion for the sign. Seconded by Pat Ruhr.

A water test of the well water was conducted by George Bradley and this was reported as okay.

Art Schlechter opened discussion re allowing individual owners to hook up cottages directly to the water line.

1. It was left to the Water Committee to find rules regarding the cost of supplying a second well and rules regarding chlorination.
2. Water Committee is to check re insurance on the well house and equipment.
3. Flooring and protection to well house to be overseen by Water Committee.

Norm Watson suggested that the empty lots need clearing. Art Schlechter is to send a letter to Doug Hunter at the Municipal Office to inform Gerry Coles re same.

John Flowers is to get a copy of the development plans re the municipality to be covered at the Meeting on October 2, 1994 with the thought of sending two members to cover the Meeting at the Municipal Office on October 14th.

We have been approached by Colesdale Park to see if we would be interested in forming a village with them. Discussion took place and it was decided that we would table it for now and let them approach us formally if they wished to pursue it further.
