

## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MCKILLOP NO. 220

BYLAW NO. 121/88

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220 to designate the property known as the Norriona Church at the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -14-23-22-W2, Saskatchewan as being a site of architectural and historical value.

WHEREAS part III of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Norriona Church at the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -14-23-22-W2 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220 enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as the Norriona Church at the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -14-23-22-W2 and legally described as:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -14-23-22-W2, Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220, Saskatchewan

The significance of the site is as follows:

- a. Constructed in 1917, the Norriona Church is one of the earliest churches in the area.
  - b. The building has served the community continuously and is presently in use.
  - c. The building is a land mark in the community.
2. The municipal administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
  3. The municipal administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
  4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
