

BYLAW NO. 178/02A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MCKILLOP NO. 220  
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN  
TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- (1) Subject to sections 2 and 3 hereof, no person shall discharge a firearm, air gun or spring gun within this municipality.
- (2) The administrator of this municipality is hereby authorized to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit in writing entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities.
- (3) This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm, air gun or spring gun is discharged outside a hamlet or organized hamlet:
  - a) by any person on land with the consent of the owner or occupant of such land;
  - b) by any person permitted to hunt under the Migratory Birds Convention Act (Canada) as amended from time to time or the regulations there under; or
  - c) where the person is the holder of a licence to hunt big game or game birds issued to him pursuant to The Wildlife Act, 1988 and hunts during the open season.
  - d) by any person who is a member of a club or organization to which a permit has been issued.
- (4) Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties stated in the municipality's general penalty Bylaw 138/93.
- (5) Bylaw 10/66A is hereby repealed.
