

BYLAW 53/76

A BYLAW RESPECTING CONTROLLING AND REGULATING CUTTING OF HAY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- (1) In this bylaw the term "public highway" does not include a provincial highway.
- (2) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality during the period $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise.
- (3) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway in this municipality so as to obstruct the travelled portion of the public highway.
- (4) For the purpose of this bylaw, prior to the 15 day of July in any year, the landowner adjacent to any public highway located in this municipality shall have first claim on the hay on that portion of the said public highway being adjacent to the landowners property.
- (5) For the purpose of this bylaw, after the 14 day of July in any year, any person may cut and use the hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality.
- (6) No person shall leave hay bales or hay stacks on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality after the 31st day of July in any year.
- (7) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
