

BYLAW NO. 162/99

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MCKILLOP NO. 220 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW 146/94 REGULATE THE PLANTING OF TREES, PLACING OF STONEPILES AND OTHER OBJECTS AND FENCES ADJACENT TO ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No 220 hereby enacts as follows:

1. No person shall hereafter plant trees or shrubs or place stone piles, structures, machinery or other objects within 10.66 metres (35 feet) of a right of way or 91.44 metres(300 feet) from an intersection of any road allowance or municipal road.
2. No person shall hereafter erect any fence for game animals within 10.66 metres(35 feet) of any right of way, road allowance or municipal road.
3. The Council may, by order, direct the owner of any private property upon which any object or fence mentioned in sections 1 and 2 has been placed in contravention of this Bylaw, to remove the same within a time stated in such order.
4. Where the owner of private property to whom an order for removal has been issued under provisions of this Bylaw fails to comply within the time stated in the order, the provisions of section 248 of the Rural Municipality Act ,1989, shall apply and the Council may, by resolution, direct such removal be carried out
5. No person shall interfere or obstruct any agent or employee of the municipality while engaged in carrying out the provisions of this Bylaw.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
7. Bylaw 72/80 and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
