



# CLUBROOT PRESENTATION

The RM of McKillop No. 220 invites all area Agricultural Producers to a presentation on the Clubroot.

Clubroot is a soil-borne disease of canola, mustard, camelina, brassica vegetables and related weeds. Currently the distribution of clubroot in Saskatchewan is limited, which puts the province in a good position to take actions to minimize its spread and severity and its impact on the Saskatchewan canola industry. Clubroot is best managed when detected early and using an integrated approach that includes extended crop rotation, clubroot-resistant varieties and prevention activities.
